



# Using Your Solid Waste Cart



All waste must be bagged before being placed in your cart.



Cart lids need to be tightly closed before carts are set out.



Property owners need to ensure that carts are securely stored.



Waste carts should be set out before 8:00 am, but not before 5:00 am on collection day. They should be retrieved no later than 7:00 pm.



In order to discourage wildlife interaction and to maintain sanitation, carts should be kept clean.

# What can go in a cart?

You can place anything [up to 100kg] in your cart which can be accepted at the landfill and which will fit into the cart without interfering with it closing, or which damages the cart.

The following items are specifically prohibited:

- liquids
- · slurry; except as permitted by bylaw
- empty steel and plastic drums, unless they are crushed, shredded or similarly reduced in volume to a condensed mass
- · contaminated soils
- · waste asbestos
- · waste oil and lubricants
- ignitable, reactive and radioactive waste
- hazardous waste, except as permitted by bylaw
- refuse that is on fire or smoldering
- · explosives
- · industrial chemical waste
- lead acid batteries
- all tires that are mounted on rims
- · unspecified chemicals and gasses

# Setting out your cart . . .

### Carts with closed lids should be placed:

- on a level surface
- no more than 2 m from the curb or roadway
- allowing overhead clearance from wires, trees and obstructions of at least 3 m
- with a minimum of 1 m of space to the sides and rear
